

## Appendix 1

### TRACKSUIT TRANSITION GUIDE 2026/2027, 2027/2028 & 2028/2029 (v.05March2026)

● New Tracksuit - Navy-based school tracksuit top, bottoms, shorts, round-neck jersey and/or a light blue polo shirt (the latter is available in most department stores)

● Old Tracksuit - Wine-coloured school tracksuit top, bottoms, shorts and a light blue polo shirt (polo shirts are available in most department stores)

● Traditional Main School Uniform – wine jumper/cardigan with school crest, grey trousers/pinafore/skirt, wine tie, blue shirt and regular school shoes

#### Key notes:

1. It is only the school tracksuit which is changing
2. The diagram above outlines the transition timeframe associated with the change. In this regard, the change pertains to new Junior Infant pupils 2026/2027 and other new school entrants (2026/2027) only. However, existing families from Senior Infants to Sixth Classes (2026/2027) will also have the option, if they wish, to purchase the new tracksuit/shorts, jersey and/or blue polo shirt or these classes may also wear the existing school tracksuit combination in 2026/2027 & 2027/2028.  
Just to note, the existing school tracksuit will not be available to purchase from suppliers from 2026/2027 onwards
3. There will be no requirement for Junior & Senior Infant pupils (2026/2027) to wear the main formal school uniform. These classes will only be required to wear the tracksuit/shorts and jersey and/or blue polo shirt combination for the full school week. However, should they wish, pupils in Senior Infants (2026/2027) may also wear their main school uniform
4. From First to Sixth Classes (2026/2027), the formal school uniform policy remains in effect, but with the option of wearing the new tracksuit/shorts, jersey or blue polo shirt or the existing tracksuit combination. Tracksuits may be worn three days per week (class teacher will advise) and the main formal school uniform for the other two days
5. \*By 2028/2029, it is anticipated that the full change of tracksuit will be complete, however, this will be reviewed again in 2027/2028
